Chronicles of the Month

December 17-18, 2025

The NSS Unit of Government Degree College, Dehra organized a one-day special camp at the End Point, near pong lake Dehra . During the competition, participants delivered insightful speeches highlighting crucial aspects of road safety such as wearing helmets, using seat belts, obeying traffic signals, avoiding the use of mobile phones while driving, and refraining from over-speeding.

Through their speeches, the students conveyed a strong message that road accidents can be effectively prevented only by strict adherence to road safety rules. The judging panel evaluated the participants on the basis of language, content, presentation, and confidence.

In the competition, **Kanika** secured the first position, **Aman** won the second position, and **Sejal** bagged the third position. On this occasion, faculty members including Prof. Nisha, Dr. Praveen, Dr. Manjoo, Prof. Shivani Gupta, and Prof. Nivedita Chauhan were also present.



December 23, 2025

A special lecture highlighting the importance of road safety was organized today at Government Degree College, Dehra. The programme aimed to create awareness among students about traffic rules and to contribute towards reducing road accidents.

The Superintendent of Police, District Dehra, **Shri Mayank Chaudhary**, graced the occasion as the chief speaker. In his address, he shed light on the fundamental principles of road safety and emphasized the mandatory use of helmets and seat belts, adherence to speed limits, avoidance of mobile phone usage while driving, and strict abstinence from driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs. He stated that most road accidents occur due to human negligence, which can be effectively prevented through caution and strict compliance with traffic rules.

In addition to road safety, Shri Chaudhary also guided the students on issues related to cybercrime, the responsible use of social media, and shared valuable tips for succeeding in competitive examinations such as the UPSC.
