Chronicles of the Month

The valedictory function of the seven-day special camp organized by the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Government College Dehra was held on **02 January 2026** in a joyful and dignified atmosphere.

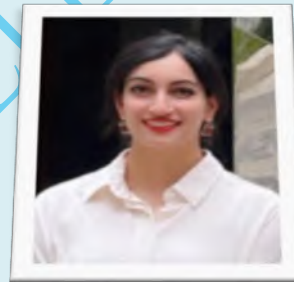
